## **HIGHWAY (JOHN)**

Since our last meeting we have graded, patched pot holes, mowing roadsides, ditching, changed two sluices, and cold patched. I had the oil separator tank pumped, Fuel tanks filled at the sand barn, plow frames are back on the trucks, and the men have been changing the tires back to winter treads. Besides regular maintenance and repairs we had a broken hydraulic line on T-119, complete service on E-115, and a new bed hoist on T-304.

## **WATER BILL LENIENCY**

On a motion made by Councilwoman Einwachter and seconded by Councilman Byington with all members in favor, Harry Kukuk's water bill will be reduced from 617.98 to 281.50 due to a water leak.

On a motion made by Councilman Byington and seconded by Councilman Underhill with all members in favor, the Whitmore Park property water bill will be reduced from 579.50 to 356.75 due to a water leak.

On a motion made by Councilman Scheid and seconded by Councilman Byington with all members in favor, Rick Stratton water bill will be reduced from 688.54 to 198.30 due to a water leak.
