HIGHWAY

Since our last meeting we have had shared services from the county to grind Block School Road, finished grading and will start spot grading shortly, changed out for sluice and cross pipes and installed concrete check dams on Wraight Rd. We started mowing roadsides for the second time around oil and stone 13 miles of road which included all of Ingleside Flaherity, Hotchkiss, Pinney, and part of Mattoon and Cook School Roads. Swept about 1/2 of the new oil and stone roads, help Pulteney under S.S with oil and stone projects, straightened out the Creek at Butts and Forest intersection, put 10 loads of gravel on frost Rd, cut three down trees, and currently we are ditching Ringrose Rd, changed pipes but still can't get tile to finish Italy Valley Road
